

52:13 Behold, my **servant**

(THE CHRIST WOULD COME TO SERVE)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many. ...but I am among you as he that serveth. **Matt. 20:28, Luke 22: 27b**

shall deal **prudently**,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE NOTABLY WISE)

**724 YEARS LATER...** And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast... And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers. **Luke. 2:42, 46-47**

he shall be **exalted and extolled**,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE A VERY WELL RECOGNIZED PERSON)

**742 YEARS LATER...** And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all. **Luke. 4:14-15**

and be **very high**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO STAND OUT FAR ABOVE OTHERS)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Phil. 2:9-11**

52:14 As many were **astonied** at thee; his **visage** was so **marred** more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE BRUTALLY DISFIGURED IN HIS FACE, OR VISAGE, AND BODY MORE THAN ANY MAN EVER HAS)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote him. And when they had blindfolded him, they struck him on the face, and asked him, saying, Prophecy, who is it that smote thee? ...Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him. And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and they put on him a purple robe, and said, Hail King of the Jews! And they smote him with their hands. **Luke. 22:63-64, John 19:1-3**

52:15 So shall he **sprinkle many nations**;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO SPRINKLE MANY NATIONS THROUGH HIS SUFFERING)

**745 YEARS LATER** ...for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; **Rev. 5:9b**

the **kings** shall shut their mouths at him: for that which had not been told them shall they see; and that which they had not heard **shall they consider**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE CONSIDERED BY KINGS)

**OVER 745 YEARS LATER...** King Agrippa, believest thou the prophets? I know that thou believest. Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian. **Acts 26:27-28**

53:1 Who hath **believed** our report?

(THE GOSPEL REPORT OF CHRIST WOULD NOT BE BELIEVED BY ALL)

**OVER 745 YEARS LATER...** But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. **Rom. 10:16-17**

and to whom is the arm of the **LORD** **revealed**?

(THE GOSPEL REPORT OF CHRIST, IF BELIEVED, WOULD HAVE TO REVEAL GOD'S POWER OF SALVATION)

**OVER 745 YEARS LATER...** To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. **1Pet. 1:4-5**

53:2 For he shall **grow up** before him as a tender plant, and **as a root out of a dry ground**:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE LITTLE CHANCE OF SURVIVAL IN HIS UPRINGING)

**713 YEARS LATER...** And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him. ...Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men. **Matt. 2:13, 16**

he hath **no form** nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is **no beauty** that we should desire him.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO COME IN THE UNDESIREABLE FORM OF A COMMON MAN)

**712 YEARS LATER...** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: **Phil. 2:6-7**

53:3 He is **despised** and **rejected** of men;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE REJECTED)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner: This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes? And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way. **Mark 12:10-12**

a man of **sorrows**,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE A MAN OF SORROWS)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy. Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me. ... And when he rose up from prayer, and was come to his disciples, he found them sleeping for sorrow. **Matt. 26: 37-38, Luke 22:45**

and **acquainted with grief**:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO KNOW AND UNDERSTAND GRIEF)

**745 YEARS LATER...** When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled. And said, Where have ye laid him? They said unto him, Lord, come and see. Jesus wept. Then said the Jews, Behold how he loved him! **John 11:33-36**

and **we hid** as it were our faces from him;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO SEE US HIDE OUR FACES FROM HIM)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And Peter went out, and wept bitterly. ...And they all forsook him, and fled. **Luke 22:61-62, Mark 14:50**

he was **despised**, and we **esteemed him not**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE DESPISED AND DISRESPECTED)

**744 YEARS LATER...** Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honor my Father, and ye do dishonor me. **John 8:48-49**

53:4 Surely he hath **born our griefs**, and carried our sorrows:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE ABLE TO TAKE OUR GRIEFS AND SORROWS UPON HIMSELF)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ...For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay them on mens shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers. **Matt. 11:28, 23:4**

yet we did esteem him **stricken**,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE STRICKEN)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophecy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands. **Mark 14:65**

smitten of **God**, and afflicted.

(PEOPLE WOULD 'ESTEEM', OR REGARD, HIM STRICKEN AND 'SMITTEN OF GOD' AS THOSE WHO WERE SUPPOSED TO REPRESENT GOD WOULD STRIKE AND SMITE HIM)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so? Jesus answered him, If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me? **John 18:22-23**

But he was **wounded** for our transgressions,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE WOUNDED)

**745 YEARS LATER...** But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. **John 19:34**

he was **bruised** for our iniquities:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE BRUISED)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him. **John 19:1**

the **chastisement of our peace** was upon him;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO OFFER US PEACE WITH GOD THROUGH HIS SUFFERING)

**745 YEARS LATER...** But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: **Eph. 2:13-16**

and with his stripes we are **healed**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD BE ABLE TO HEAL US OF OUR SIN)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. **1Pet. 2:24**

53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the **LORD** hath laid on him the iniquity of **us all**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO DIE FOR THE SINS OF US ALL)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Who wil have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. **1Tim. 2:4-6**

53:7 He was **oppressed**,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO EXPERIENCE OPPRESSION)

**712 YEARS LATER...** For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich. **2Cor. 8:9**

and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought **as a lamb** to the slaughter,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE SACRIFICED 'AS A LAMB')

**745 YEARS LATER...** After two days was the feast of the \*passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put him to death. **Mark 14:1**

\* (Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take you a lamb according to your families, and kill the Passover. **Ex. 12:21** )

and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he **openeth not his mouth**.

(THE CHRIST WOULD REMAIN SILENT WHEN ACCUSED)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing. **Matt. 27:12**

53:8 He was taken from **prison**

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE TAKEN FROM PRISON)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Now at that feast the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would...But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus. **Matt. 27:15,**

and from **judgment**:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE TAKEN FROM JUDGMENT)

**745 YEARS LATER...** When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat... But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar. Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led him away. **John 19:13a, 15-16**

and who shall declare his generation? for he was **cut off** out of the land of the living:

(THE CHRIST WOULD BE MURDERED EARLY IN LIFE)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? And they have slain them which showed before the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers: **Acts 7:52**
