(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO DIE FOR THE SINFULNESS OF PEOPLE, NOT FOR HIMSELF)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him, and led him away to Annas first; for he was father in law to Caiaphas, which was the high priest that same year. Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people. **John 18:12-14**

**53:9** And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death;

(THE CHRIST WOULD MAKE HIS GRAVE WITH THE RICH)

**745 YEARS LATER...** When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple: He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed. **Matt. 27:57-60**

because he had done no violence,

(THE CHRIST WOULD NOT DO VIOLENCE)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword. **Matt.26:52**

neither was any deceit in his mouth.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE PERFECTLY HONEST EVEN IF IT COST HIM HIS LIFE)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Judas then, having received a band of men and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and weapons. Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye? They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them. **John 18:3-5**

**53:10** Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him;

(THERE WOULD BE SUCH GREAT PURPOSE FOR HIM TO SUFFER THAT IT WOULD EVEN PLEASE THE LORD TO DO SO)

**745 YEARS LATER...** In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. **1John 4:9-10**

he hath put him to grief:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE PUT TO GRIEF)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? **Matt. 27:46**

when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin,

(IT WOULD BE THE LORD'S WILL TO OFFER THE CHRIST)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt. **Matt. 26:39**

(THE CHRIST WOULD BE OFFERED NOT ONLY IN BODY ON EARTH, BUT ALSO IN HIS SOUL BY TAKING OUR SIN TO HELL)

**745 YEARS LATER...** He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. **Acts 2:31**

he shall see his seed,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO SEE HIS SPIRITUAL SEED AS A RESULT OF THIS OFFERING)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. ...The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. **Gal. 3:29, Rom. 8:16-17**

he shall prolong his days,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE POWER TO BECOME ALIVE AGAIN, PROLONGING HIS DAYS, AFTER GOD OFFERS HIM FOR OUR SIN)

**745 YEARS LATER...** To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God: **Acts 1:3**

and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

(AFTER HIS RESURRECTION, THE PLEASURE OF THE LORD WOULD PROSPER AND GROW AS A MOVEMENT UNDER HIS LEADERSHIP)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; **Col. 1:18-19**

**53:11** He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied:

(AS HIS SOUL IS MADE AN OFFERING FOR SIN, THE CHRIST WOULD SATISFY GOD'S WRATH AGAINST SIN)

**745 YEARS LATER...** But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. **Rom. 5:8-9**

by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BE RIGHTEOUS TO BE ABLE TO JUSTIFY SINNERS)

**745 YEARS LATER...** To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. **Rom. 3:26**

(THE CHRIST WOULD BE ABLE TO GIVE ETERNAL LIFE TO SINNERS 'BY HIS KNOWLEDGE')

**745 YEARS LATER...** And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. **1John 5:20**

**53:12** Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great,

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO BECOME ONE OF 'THE GREAT' IN HISTORY)

**743 YEARS LATER...** The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here. The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here. **Matt. 12:41-42**

and he shall divide the spoil with the strong;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO SHARE THE SPOILS OF HIS VICTORY)

**745 YEARS LATER...** Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. ...Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. ...And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all. **Col. 2:14-15, Eph. 4:8, Acts 3:16**

because he hath poured out his soul unto death:

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO DIE OBEDIENTLY)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. ... And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost. **Phil. 2:8, Luke 23:46**

and he was numbered with the transgressors;

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO DIE AMONG TRANSGRESSORS)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And with him they crucify two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. **Mark 15:27-28**

and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

(THE CHRIST WOULD HAVE TO MAKE INTERCESSION FOR US)

**745 YEARS LATER...** And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. ... But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. **Luke 23:33-34, Heb. 7:24-25**

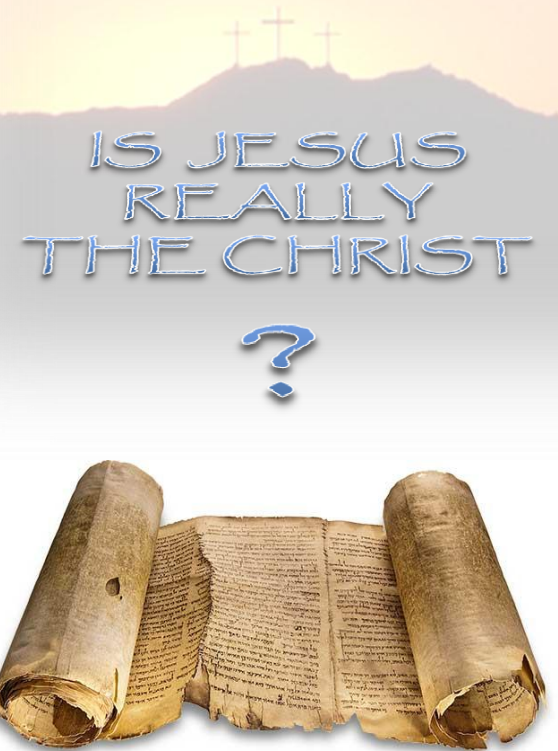
- 1) YOU are NOT the Christ and therefore do not deserve eternal life by your own righteousness.

In the book of Isaiah the prophet, pictured above, there are many references to the Christ that were written over seven hundred years before the time of Jesus. In many of these, the Christ is referred to as "my servant". In chapter 49 and verse 6, for example, it says, "And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldst be my servant\* to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee a light for the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth." Please take notice that "my servant" is not a reference to Israel, or a tribe, but an individual person. This individual is to be God's servant that will offer God's salvation to all the earth. Considering this, what question could possibly be more important than the title of this pamphlet?! This short study is a look at one prophetic passage out of scores of others in the Bible that deals with the qualifications for a person to be 'the Christ'. It should also be noted, that according to Gen. 49:10, the nation of Israel must maintain their power to give and execute laws until the Christ should come. Israel lost this power in 7 A.D., which is why Jesus was crucified (Roman) and not stoned (Jewish). This means that the Christ had to be here by 7 A.D., or the prophecies of the Bible could not be taken literally. No one in history stands out like Jesus as a candidate for 'the Christ'. You might ask, "Could it really be true?!" Forty nine ways Jesus *literally* fulfilled the requirements to be the Christ are shown in this pamphlet from Isaiah's famous prophecy in Isa. 52:13 through 53:12.
